Art must be dry and ready to hang, no saw tooth hangers Painting size limits are 24 x 36 and scultors size and weight must be easy to move. Sculptors must also provide their own stands.

All work must be picked-up by 5 p.m. the same day. Artists accepted return with accepted art on Saturday at 8 a.m

Awards will be presented at 3:00 p.m.

All decisions will be final,.

\$300 for Best Western Art.
